Your application must include the following. If any information is missing, your app will be thrown out:

1. List involvement in school, church, and/or civic activities. For each activity, list leadership role(s) and/or awards associated.
2. *Official* transcript. Also *official* documentation of GPA, ACT/SAT, and class rank. This information must be on school letterhead and signed by a school official with a school seal.
3. List the years of involvement and the specific duties you have had on a harvest operations. If you have not been active in harvest, please state why and detail what activities and/or jobs you have had during harvest time.
4. One page essay (size 12 font, double-spaced) of the impact harvest has had on your life. Include harvest experiences, involvement, and goals and plans for the future. Please know that the office blocks out **all** names, brand names, cities, and states from your essay. The scholarship committee judges all applications without any identifying information.
5. 2 letters of recommendation that include the name and phone number of persons verifying your work on harvest. Recommendation letters may **not** be written by parents, co-workers, or school officials. Use someone who has been a part of your harvest life and knows the work you do for the business.
6. Include or email (office@uschi.com) a picture of yourself for office use. This will be published in the *Harvest News* and possibly used in the scholarship presentation at the convention.
7. IF you have previously been awarded the scholarship, please include an additional essay demonstrating financial need. An essay of financial need is to be submitted **ONLY** by previous scholarship recipients.
